# State Cup/Tournaments



By the time you are reading this we will have completed the first two weeks of State Cup. There are actually three separate tournaments within the Cal South State Cup competition. The State Cup is divided into two divisions: Presidents & Governors.

The Governors division is open to all teams playing in the Bronze or below like signature or recreation league teams in the U16 or below age group. The younger division (U9 to U13) have a tentative finish date of Feb. 20th. The older division (U14 to U17) tentative start date is March 31st and goes through April 22nd.

The Presidents division the U9, 10, 11, 18 & 19 age groups are open to all play levels. the U12 to U17 are open to the Silver Elite division or lower. The youngsters (U9 to U13) has a tentative finish date of March 4th. The older (U14 to U19) have a tentative start date of April 14th and tentative finish date of April 29th.

The National Cup is for those teams playing in the Gold or Premier divisions of league play. Their tentative start date for the youngsters (U12/13) is Feb. 18th with a tentative finish date of March 18th. The older (U14 to U18) have a tentative start date of April 21st with a tentative finish date of May 20th. Boys/Girls U19 will start Memorial Day Weekend, May 26-28th.



The Cal South NCSA College showcase weekend for National Cup (U15 to U17 players) will be held May 12/13 in Lancaster.

I am not told which of the above we receive. You will have to go to the Cal South State/National Cup web-site to check out the field you are assigned to see which games you are assigned.

There are two weekends that NO GAMES will be played. Feb. 25/26 is Soccer Nation weekend. April 7/8 is Easter weekend.

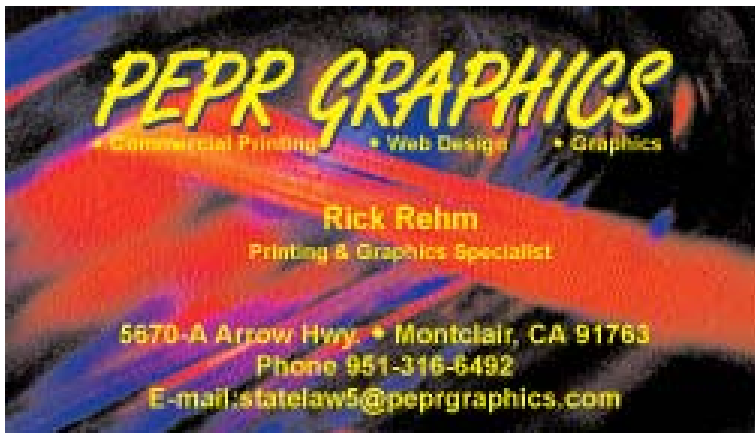
