The summer is a great time to relax and start preparing the fall season. For those of you that referee college and high school season, those seasons are going to be here before you know it. Are you ready? Are you physically fit? Are you mentally ready for the elements in the game? I believe we will have some youth tournaments during the summer. Make sure that you give the kids 110% every time that you are out there on the field.

This past weekend, we had the Legends FC tournament. I believe overall, the tournament was a success. There is always going to be some complaints or comments about the refereeing, but in a whole, I believe we did well. There is still plenty of room for improvement. First off, if you do not have the necessary uniforms, please make sure to pick up the uniforms. If you are missing a couple of colors, start by picking up 1 at a time until you have all the uniforms. If you cannot afford short and long sleeve, start with the long sleeve because you can make a long sleeve turn into short sleeve. If you have all the colors, then start working on getting the opposite sleeve length; if you have had your jerseys for a few years, maybe it is time to upgrade your jerseys (some might be looking a little faded). Lastly is positioning; make sure you are in the proper position and able to make the necessary calls at the correct time. Remember, for these players, this is their World Cup! If you are not physically fit enough to referee the numbers of games assigned, please do not take the assignment.


