The Recertification Exam!!!

It is that time of the year again where we all take the recertification exam. Remember, the exam will cover the Laws of the Game, not the rules of soccer or anything else, the Laws of the Game. Make sure you study up on the USSF Laws of the Game as some of us are in different mind sets right now; college or high school. Please make sure when it comes to the recertification exam Thursday night, you are in the right mind set. The recertification fee for grades 8 is \$45.00, grade 7 is \$50.00, and grade 5-6 is \$80.00. We will not be accepting registration forms at the meeting. Once you complete your recertification exam, your name will be added to the database showing that you have completed the exam. You can obtain the registration form from the Cal South website, www.calsouth.com, Referees, Registration. Once on the page please download and fill out the registration form. If you have the form filled out prior to Thursday night, please bring the form with you and I will certify that you took the test. We will have a few blank forms at the meeting.

Please make sure to attend the meeting on Thursday night. This is your only chance to take the recertification exam at Tri-County's monthly meeting. We are trying to get for November the Live Scan Company to come out and live scan all the referees present. Remember, Live Scan, is a requirement for youth games beginning January 2010 for referees over 18 years of age.
