Recertification Test!!!

Another month is here. League has started and College soccer season is in full swing. By now, hopefully if you are planning on refereeing High School, you have already at least attended Session 1. If you have not, please make sure you contact Ron Cardin, Instructional Chair for FCSOA to find out more information.

This month at our meeting, we will be administering the Grade 8 recertification exam. This year, you will be required to take the whole 100 question exam and successfully pass with a score of 75% or better.

Please make sure you are ready to take the exam prior to Thursday night. Additionally, please make sure you have acquired the required number of recertification hours for your grade. Reminder....

Grade 8 – 5 hours of recertification credit, successfully pass recertification exam with 75% or better

Grade 7 – 8 hours of recertification credit, successfully pass recertification exam with 85% or better

Grade 6 – 8 hours of recertification credit, successfully pass recertification exam with 75% or better.1 Center assessment Adult Division 2 of higher

Grade 5 – 8 hours of recertification credit, successfully pass recertification exam with 85% or better.1 Center assessment Adult Division 1 of higher

Emeritus Grade 15 & 16 - 5 hours of recertification credit, successfully pass recertification exam.

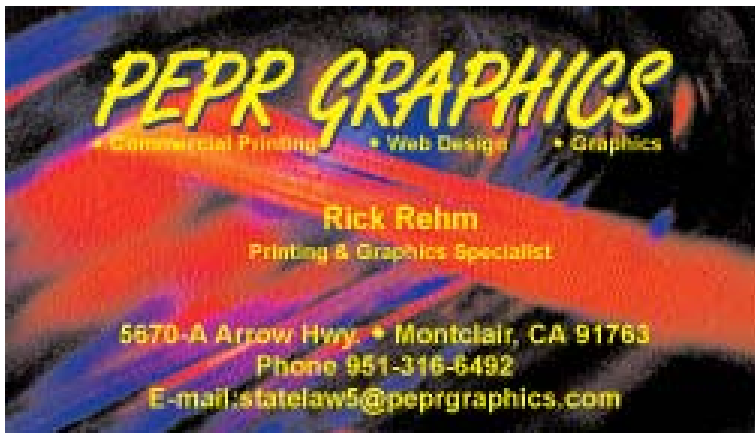
