Remember, our October meeting is going to be our recertification meeting for the grade 8's only. If you are a grade 8, please make sure you attend the meeting. By the meeting, hopefully the recertification test registration will be posted online. Once it's posted, I will have Rick and Bob send out all the information via email to all our members. This is the only time that TCSRA will be hosting the recert for 2011. If you miss the meeting, you will be able to take the test at any other association (that has not already offered the test) or at the state up-recert meetings in November/December.

Fall Soccer Season to Start this Saturday



Unless you have been in hibernation, you all should know by now about our fall season. There will be two leagues in our area. We have more than enough games for all of our members. If you are not receiving e-mails from me at least once a week, let me know asap. Rick will have the new CSL rule books for everyone at our meeting. The SCDSL has their rules on-line to review and print out. Make sure you are familiar with all of them. The substitution rules are completely different for each league. I will be sending out update e-mails often on any changes that effect us regarding either of these two leagues. Make sure you are checking your e-mail messages daily so not to be left behind in the latest information.

Lewis will have checks for everyone that did games to the United Cup and the West Coast Futbol Classic. He has a lot of them so please make every effort to attend this meeting. If there is any question on the amount of your check, let me know right away. He also has a few checks from past tournaments. If you are not sure if you have one coming, check with Lewis at our meeting.

I have a lot of U19 matches to assign this fall season. If you need an assessment game, let me know your availability for the season right away. That age group pretty much ends about 5-6 weeks into the season. Don't wait until the end to request a match for your upgrade or maintenance. I will do my best to

fit you in your schedule if you let me know within the next week or so. I have already started filling slots from some referees wanting those matches.

We have an awful lot of U9/10 matches. They can be assigned with one referee or three. If you are new and want to start off in that division, I can assign you to be an asst. referee. This is usually a great place to begin your referee career. Less players on the field and easier to officiate.

I have found that a lot of our members change their e-mail address or phone numbers and forget to tell me the changes. When sending your availability, please include your cell phone. That way I can let you know of any last minute changes on game day.

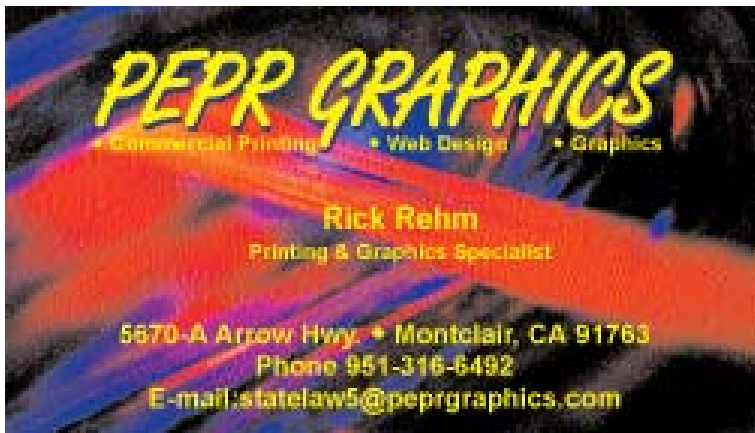
